1. In accordance with the authority contained in references (a) and (b), on 6 August 1960, you will proceed to the U. S. Naval Hospital, Bethesda, Maryland, reporting upon arrival, not later than 0800 that date, to the Officer of the Day, thereat, for temporary additional duty as an escort for the remains of the late Lance Corporal Gulford G. NELSON 15A7466 USMC, for a period of about three (3) days.
2. Upon completion of the above temporary additional duty and when directed by competent authority, you will return to this command and resume your regular duties.
3. The Post Supply Officer is directed to furnish the necessary transportation between Marine Barracks, Washington, D. C. and U. S. Naval Hospital, Bethesda, Maryland. All other travel involved in the execution of these orders will be performed by commercial carrier by government transportation requests. These transportation requests will be furnished at your temporary additional duty station.
4. In the event the delay at the destination is to exceed seventy-two (72) hours, you will advise the Commanding Officer by collect telegram of the reason for the delay and request instructions.
5. You are authorized to purchase a floral tribute at the place of interment in accordance with reference (c), the cost not to exceed \$20.00, directing that the invoice be forwarded by the vendor to the Commandant of the Marine Corps (Code DSU), Headquarters, U. S. Marine Corps, Washington 25, D. C. for settlement, and that the card attached to the floral tribute be worded "UNITED STATES MARINE CORPS".
6. You are authorized to draw advance per diem in the execution of these orders.
7. Upon arrival at the burial site, you will render all possible assistance to the next of kin to the deceased. Further you will obtain the lot number, plot number and location of the Cemetery in which the deceased is buried in order that the Commandant of the Marine Corps (Code DNI) may be informed.
8. Expenditures under these orders are chargeable to appn. 1701304.1840 OMN CC C23, RAN 77600, BGN 30001, AMH 18.
