

1. In accordance with the authority contained in reference (a), you will take charge of the personnel listed on enclosure (1) and proceed on 23 October 1962, to Marine Corps Schools, Quantico, Virginia, reporting upon arrival to the Commanding Officer, 2d Battalion, 22d Marines, thereat, for temporary additional duty undergoing field training in FEX Quantico, for a period of about 10 days.

2. You are Officer in Charge of all Hotel Company troops and as such have the following specific responsibilities in addition to that of supervision normal to Officer in Charge status:

- a. Conduct and supervision of all training conducted during this FEX.
- b. Insuring positive compliance by all members of this detail with appropriate Marine Corps Schools Regulations, including those applicable to range useage, and with generally accepted common sense safety precautions covering the handling and firing of weapons and live ammunition.
- c. Violations of the UCMJ will be referred to this Headquarters immediately, for appropriate disciplinary action.

3. Commanding Officer, 2d Battalion, 22d Marines, will assume operational control of "H" Company during this FEX; administrative control remains with Commanding Officer, Marine Barracks, Washington, D. C.

4. Upon completion of the above temporary additional duty and when directed by proper authority, you will take charge of the personnel under your charge and return to this Barracks and resume your regular duties.

5. The Barracks Motor Transport Officer is directed to provide the necessary transportation in the execution of these orders.
